



## Creative Story Writing Assignment

Title: "The Secret Door"

### Assignment Instructions:

Imagine you are exploring an old library, an ancient castle, or even your own house when you suddenly discover a secret door. It could be hidden behind a bookshelf, under a rug, or in a place you never expected!

## Creative Poetry Assignment

Title: "A World of Imagination"

### Assignment Instructions:

Your poem should include:

- At least 8 lines (but you can write more!)

Draw or describe what your imaginary world looks like!

Example Poem Starter:

"High in the sky, past the bright shining sun,

## Writing Activity: “A Day as a Superhero!”

### Instructions:
